A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A DONATION OF ROPE RESCUE EQUIPMENT FROM SOUTHERN SPRINGS MASK PRODUCTIONS BY CELESTE SCHMIDT AND SUE TINKER


WHEREAS, the Spring Hill Fire Department occasionally uses rescue equipment specifically for rope operations throughout the surrounding cities and counties; and

WHEREAS, Spring Hill Fire Department currently uses 1/2" Rope, 1" tubular webbing, and 8mm prusik cord to support such systems. These are consumable products that must be taken out of the system and replaced when they are past their shelf life or put under a considerable shock load.

WHEREAS, The Southern Springs Mask Productions by Celeste Schmidt and Sue Tinker is offering to donate a 600' of 1/2" rope, 600' of 1" tubular webbing, and 50' of 8mm prusik cord valued at approximately \$1,000.00 to supplement our existing equipment and replace any when necessary.



Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee on the 19th day of October, 2020.




