**WHEREAS**, the Spring Hill Police Department was allocated funding to purchase one (1) new police vehicle in the 2020-2021 fiscal budget; and


**WHEREAS**, the amount funded, \$49,500.00 will cover the cost of the vehicle and installed equipment; and


**WHEREAS**; City staff has reviewed prior proposals and has made a recommendation to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen.

Department Budget Status:

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I. Purpose/Overview: To purchase Ford Interceptor, (Explorer) for traffic officer that both position and vehicle were approved for current fiscal budget.

II. Background Information: BOMA approved 2020-2021 budget to hire a traffic officer with vehicle. Vehicle budget was \$49,500.00 to include equipment. Dodge Chrysler in Columbia, did not receive any Dodge Chargers and do not have any in stock. Lonnie Cobb Ford, state contract vendor, sent an email to police departments, advertising 2 Ford interceptors for sale. The interceptors were on display at the chief's conference at the vendor expo. The vehicle is fully loaded, which includes lights, siren, cage, etc. The department will still have to purchase a few equipment items, ie. Video camera and sierra GPS locator and radios, in which the radio is budgeted in a separate line item

The price of the vehicle falls with in our budgeted amount and will allow us to purchase the vehicle, equipped, and be ready to be put into service. This is a state contract purchase.

III. Financial Impact to Budget. \$40,392.00
