A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE PURCHASE OF EXMARK MOWER FOR THE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill is in need of an additional mower to maintain parks and recreation areas within the city limits; and

WHEREAS, the City recommends the purchase of a 60" Exmark zero turn mower from Dickerson Landscaper's Depot through Sourcewell contract, of which the city is a member; and

WHEREAS, the Sourcewell purchase price of the mower is \$10,659.00; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Alderman allocated funds for this purchase in the January 2021 budget amendment for the Parks and Recreation department (\$10,500.00) with the balance (\$159.00) coming from the FY '20/'21 Parks and Recreation department budget.



PURPOSE:

The Parks and Recreation Commission and Department is in need of an additional mower for the maintenance of the current city parks and projected incoming greenway/walking trail dedications scheduled for 2021-2023.

BACKGROUND:

A new 60” zero turn mower is needed as one of our existing daily service zero turn mowers currently has 1700 hours of use which exceeds its recommended life expectancy of 1500 hours. The 60” John Deere is still in service but has begun to experience repeated breakdowns and less than desirable performance despite regular maintenance and timely repairs. The Parks and Recreation Department will be taking on the additional maintenance of new trails and greenways scheduled to be constructed and/or dedicated to the City in 2021-2023. The John Deere mentioned above will remain in the fleet as a back-up and to be used to drag the softball fields at Evans Park. The projected cost of \$10,500.00 was presented to the BOMA in January of 2020 as a CIP item. The Board of Mayor and Alderman allocated funds for this purchase in the January 2021 budget amendment. Since the initial estimate, the cost has gone up to \$10,659.00. The balance over budget of \$159.00 can be absorbed in the FY ‘20/’21 Parks and Recreation department budget.
