

RESOLUTION 21-81

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO ENTER INTO
CONTRACT NEGOTIATIONS WITH PAM CASKIE FOR THE POSITION OF CITY
ADMINISTRATOR**

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill currently has a vacancy in the position of City Administrator; and

WHEREAS, appointment of the City Administrator is the responsibility and duty of the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen (“BOMA”); and

WHEREAS, the BOMA desires to appoint a new City Administrator finding it in the best interest of the City of Spring Hill; and

WHEREAS, the City has participated in a process facilitated by the University of Tennessee Municipal Technical Advisory Service to identify and select the best candidate to serve as the City’s next City Administrator.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen hereby authorize the City Attorney to enter into contract negotiations with Pam Caskie to serve as the City’s next City Administrator.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, upon completion of said negotiations, the City Administrator shall present the negotiated contract to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen for approval and execution via separate Resolution.
