A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING “STAND DOWN FOR SAFETY”

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Alderman of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee identifies health and safety of its employees and citizens as a top priority; and

WHEREAS, the Safety Committee of the City of Spring Hill is sponsoring a program called, “Stand Down for Safety” which includes a full day of safety training for employees; and

WHEREAS, October 11, 2021 is Columbus Day which is a recognized holiday for some government agencies; and

WHEREAS, the Safety Committee is proposing a day of safety training to be held on October 11, 2021 (Columbus Day) in which all employees will gather in the morning to interdepartmentally meet as an organization at Station Hill Church.
