WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen approved a Professional Services Agreement with Thomas and Hutton Engineering (formerly Dempsey Dilling and Associates) for variety of professional engineering, design, and municipal support services; and

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill received a Director's Order (WPC22-0001) dated January 31, 2022 and received by Spring Hill on February 15, 2022 requiring the development of a CAP/ER action plan response; and

WHEREAS, the Spring Hill Wastewater Treatment Plant is in need of professional services to develop the response plan of action for the Director's Order (WPC22-0001); and

WHEREAS, Thomas and Hutton Engineering has provided the City with a proposal for Engineering Services for the Wastewater Treatment Plant response under our existing contract with the City not to exceed \$12,000.00

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill authorize Thomas and Hutton Engineering to provide engineering services for Wastewater Treatment Plant Director's Order CAP/ER action plan response for a total not to exceed cost of \$12,000.00

Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee on this 7th day of March, 2022.



The purpose of this resolution is to award the professional services agreement to Thomas & Hutton for engineering services and to authorize the Mayor to execute the contract.

BACKGROUND:

The City of Spring Hill Wastewater Treatment Plant is currently in receipt of a Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation Director's Order. The City currently has a need to respond with the development of a CAP/ER which addresses how the exceeded limits of effluent listed in the Director's Order will be eliminated.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The proposed lump sum cost of \$12,000.00 will be funded through the Water and Sewer Fund with a total not to exceed budget of \$12,000.00

Staff recommends approval of Resolution 22-41 to approve the contract to Thomas & Hutton and to authorize the Mayor to sign the contract for the professional engineering services of Thomas & Hutton.


Dear Mr. Allen:
