

Resolution No. 22-51

**A RESOLUTION TO DESIGNATE PREVIOUSLY ALLOCATED BUT UNDESIGNATED
TOURISM FUNDS TO THE SPRING HILL CHAMBER OF COMMERCE.**

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Alderman of the City of Spring Hill is committed to promote tourism in the city;

WHEREAS, on January 3rd, 2022, the Board of Mayor and Alderman passed Ordinance 21-26, which allocated \$10,000 from the Tourism Fund as an undesignated donation; and

WHEREAS, the Board recognizes that the Spring Hill Chamber of Commerce has engaged in an initiative to promote tourism in the city; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to partner with the Spring Hill Chamber of Commerce to promote tourism in Spring Hill.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT BE RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF SPRING HILL, TENNESSEE, BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN, that because promoting tourism in the City of Spring Hill is in the city's best interests, \$10,000 previously allocated but undesignated from the Tourism fund shall be designated as a donation to the Spring Hill Chamber of Commerce for use for their tourism initiative.

This resolution shall take effect after adoption by affirmative vote of the Board of Mayor and Alderman, the public welfare requiring it.
