

RESOLUTION 22-119

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SETTLEMENT

WHEREAS, Joan Johnson and James Scruggs, as natural parents, friends and next of kin of Shane Scruggs, deceased, (“Plaintiffs”) filed a lawsuit against the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee (“the City”) and Spring Hill Police Department, and Williamson County, Tennessee and Williamson County Department of Emergency Communications in the Maury County Circuit Court bearing docket number 16952; and

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee (“the City”), has been involved in negotiations to resolve said claim; and

WHEREAS, a settlement was reached among the parties whereby the City has agreed to pay Plaintiffs a total of \$7,500.00 in full and final settlement of this matter; and

WHEREAS, the City’s insurance carrier will pay the settlement amount minus the \$1,000.00 deductible, which will be paid by the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Aldermen (“BOMA”) authorizes the full resolution of the lawsuit with Plaintiffs by causing to be paid to Plaintiffs Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$7,500.00) and further authorizes the Mayor and City Attorney to execute any and all settlement documentation necessary to effectuate same.
