

RESOLUTION 22-163

A RESOLUTION TO USE DMD CONSULTANTS FOR THE SECOND YEAR OF A 2 YEAR CONTRACT FOR FIRE HYDRANT MAINTENANCE.

WHEREAS, the City of Spring Hill Fire Department has identified a need for regular maintenance and painting of fire hydrants.

WHEREAS, the city agreed to a 2-year contract with DMD Consultants and this would be the second year of the contract; and .

WHEREAS the DMD Consultants was the lowest bidder for services and repairs as needed; and

WHEREAS funding for the fire hydrant maintenance services is budgeted in the 2022-2023 budget year with fire \$50,000 and the Water Distribution department and \$120,000 in the for a total of \$170,000.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the City of Spring Hill Board of Mayor and Alderman, to authorize the spending to not exceed \$170,000 for fire hydrant maintenance and painting by DMD Consultants.

Passed and Adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee on the 1st day of August, 2022.



RE: To approve DMD Consultants for Hydrant Maintenance and Painting

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this resolution is to approve the use of funds and use DMD consultants for the 2nd year of a 2-year contract for Hydrant maintenance and painting.

BACKGROUND:

The city requires to contract with an outside vendor to provide annual maintenance and painting as needed for all fire hydrants within city limits. The maintenance would include disassembly, inspection, repairs, and reassembly of each hydrant and then sandblasting and painting each in accordance with city specifications. not all hydrants will require extensive repairs; staff estimates \$1,500 per hydrant if a rebuild is necessary. however, it is estimated to that very few will have to be rebuilt in entirety.

The contract was awarded in 2021 and it was for 2 years. This will be the second year of this contract.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The funding for the maintenance services is budgeted in the fy 22/23 budget year for \$120,000 in the water distribution (410-52100-392) and \$50,000 in the fire department departmental budgets (110-42200-943) for a total of \$170,000.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of Resolution 22-163 to:

1. To use DMD Consultants for the second year of a two-year contract for fire hydrant maintenance.
