WHEREAS, funding for this item is included within the IT Department budget.



Passed and adopted by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Spring Hill, Tennessee, this 5th day of September 2022.





RESOLUTION 22-194 – A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE ANNUAL EXPENSE FOR DATTO HARDWARE, SOFTWARE AND SUPPORT FROM STRINGFELLOW TECHNOLOGIES.

Purpose:

The City of Spring Hill approved a contract with Stringfellow Technologies in 2018. This is the third year of the contract. In order to comply with purchasing policy, a blanket PO for monthly fee should be approved.

Background Information:

Spring Hill had ransomware event in November 2017. Systems were recovered promptly but data recovery was a lengthy and expensive endeavor. Most utility and finance data had to be manually input. Researched and received recommendations that DATTO SIRIS 3 data protection platform and software would meet and exceed the requirements expected. Submitted RFP for DATTO Siris 3, Ransomware Protection and Recovery software, 12TB hardware and annual support. Received and reviewed submitted responses to the RFP from three vendors based on pricing and support services. This is the third year of the contract with Stringfellow.

Staff Request:

Staff request approval of resolution for expenditure of funds in the amount of \$14,385.60, which will be a monthly invoice of \$1,198.80, for continued software and hardware support from Stringfellow Technology Group, Nashville, TN.

I. Purpose: The City of Spring Hill researched ransomware protection and recovery options with software and hardware support.

II. Background Information:

- a. Spring Hill had ransomware event in November 2017.
- b. Systems were recovered promptly but data recovery was a lengthy and expensive endeavor. Most utility and finance data had to be manually input.
- c. Researched and received recommendations that DATTO SIRIS 3 data protection platform and software would meet and exceed the requirements expected.
- d. Submitted RFP for DATTO Siris 3, Ransomware Protection and Recovery software, 12TB hardware and annual support.
- e. Received and reviewed submitted responses to the RFP from three vendors based on pricing and support services.

III. Staff Request:

- a. Staff request approval of resolution for expenditure of funds in the amount of a one-time fee of \$9,445 for DATTO Siris 3 Enterprise 12000 and setup and an annual fee for a period of three (3) years for proposed Option B Monthly Backup and Recovery Services of \$14,385.60 for software and hardware support from Stringfellow Technology Group, Nashville, TN.
- b. Note: This is a budgeted item however,
 1. Staff requested both offsite storage options for price comparisons
 1. Option A cost for Monthly Backup and Recovery Services is based on one (1) year of offsite cloud storage and come in on budget.
 2. Option B provides infinite offsite cloud storage. Option B brings project total \$781.28 over approved budget. IT department can cover this amount from another line item.
