**WHEREAS**, annual dues are set by GNRC and assessed based on population; the current dues rate is 35 cents per capita; and


**WHEREAS**, dues are used to match or supplement federal and state grant programs that qualify our community for social services and infrastructure investments.

Please find attached your annual invoice for regional dues for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023, payable upon receipt. This invoice includes your community's local contribution to the Greater Nashville Regional Council (GNRC) for programs that support aging and disability services, economic and community development assistance, and regional infrastructure planning across Middle Tennessee.

GNRC was established by the Tennessee General Assembly as the state development district for northern Middle Tennessee. Membership dues account for only 4 percent of the annual budget and are critical to drawing down more than \$18 million to fund activities that keep your community eligible for billions in state and federal grants made available for infrastructure projects and social services.
